(Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC)

Hereby OPS Paper Products Sdn. Bhd. explicitly states that it has read and understood the "Policy for the Association of Organizations with FSC" as published under www.fsc.org. This policy stipulates FSC's position with regards to unacceptable activities by organizations and individuals which already are or would like to be associated with FSC as well as the mechanism for disassociation.

In light of the above, OPS Paper Products Sdn. Bhd. explicitly agrees currently and, in the future, as long as the relationship with FSC exists, not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following unacceptable activities:

- a) Illegal harvesting or illegal trade in forest products;
- b) Violation of customary or human rights within the forestry or forest products sector;
- c) Violation of workers' rights and principles defined in the International Labour Organization (ILO) Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work within the forestry or forest products sector;
- d) Destruction of High Conservation Values (HCVs) in forests or High Conservation Value areas;
- e) Conversion of natural forest cover:
